

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The TPA Competition Code of Conduct and compulsory Integrity Education Courses apply to this Competition.

1. All resident Australian competitors must be financial members of Target Pistol Australia.
2. Competitors may be asked to provide proof that they are a current member of their State/Territory Association.
3. Entries close Friday April 2nd 2027. Entry fees must be paid at the time of submitting the entry form online and/or payment notification provided. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Secretary and will be subject to an additional late entry fee.
4. Entries without full payment will not be accepted.
5. Phone entries will not be accepted.
6. Full metal jacket (FMJ) projectiles are prohibited on all ranges.
7. Provisional State/Territory team lists to be received no later than March 15th to assist with squadding.
8. Pistol licences/permits must be submitted for checking at Equipment Control.
9. Competitors, officials and visitors to the range will be required to sign in to the range via the clubroom sign-in register each day and to wear official identification cards while on the venue.
10. Competitors, officials and coaches must comply with the TPA Dress Code.
11. Competitors are not permitted to wear tank tops, garments with loose fitting necks or camouflage clothing.
12. ISSF and Target Pistol Australia Rules will be followed as closely as is practicable.
13. The 10m SIUS targets at MISC are not equipped with witness strips. For this reason ISSF Rule 6.10.8 "PROCEDURE FOR EXAMINING ELECTRONIC SCORING TARGETS FOLLOWING A SCORE PROTEST OR COMPLAINT" cannot be applied in its entirety. Score value protests cannot be accepted except in the case of a failure to register a shot. Investigations will necessarily be limited to examination of the system logs.
14. Competitors who remain in shooting bays while personnel are down range must not touch or handle firearms. Competitors in breach of this policy will be disqualified from the event.
15. Firearms and gun boxes must not be left unattended anywhere on the facilities.
16. Handguns and competitors' equipment (gun cases, bags, etc.) are not permitted in club rooms at any time.
17. Signage will indicate warm-up areas. These areas are to be used for any handling of uncased firearms. No ammunition is permitted to be used in any warm-up area.
18. Smart watches, mobile phones & other telecommunication devices used on the range must be placed in Flight Mode, **before** entering any ranges.
19. Smoking/vaping is not permitted on any range or any indoor areas at any time. Please use designated smoking areas.
20. Alcohol is not permitted on any range at any time. BYO alcohol is not permitted at any time.
21. Alcohol may be consumed at the conclusion of the competitor's program for the day.
22. IMPORTANT NOTE: By entering this competition, you acknowledge that all results will be published on the VAPA, TPA and MISC websites and social media platforms. You also acknowledge that the video and your photograph may be taken during the competition and may be published on all the VAPA, TPA and MISC websites and social media platforms, including future Range Reports.
